What is it?

Household Hazardous Waste can come from products for the lawn and garden, automotive lubricants, cleaners, paints, and solvents.

Improper disposal of these and other household hazardous products can contaminate the land, air, and water supply, and it can pose a threat to our health. Many can cause serious injury to the employees who pick up your garbage.

Transport materials safely in vehicles to the collection event by securing the load to prevent shifting, which can cause damage or leakage.



Make sure containers are closed and are not leaking.

Whenever possible, avoid purchasing such items because of the disposal liabilities and costs.

If you must purchase them, buy in small quantities for immediate use. Please consider alternative products that are environmentally friendly and much safer to handle.

- Technological Products: computers, printers, TV's , speakers, electronic equipment

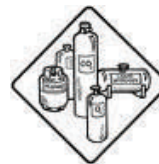
